The contractor has moved on to other areas until they can figure a way to get from McCook to Lexington. The OCIO office is working to build a new tower at the Cambridge Lake to accommodate these needs. FirstNet is taking hold and Nebraska has received notice of the award of funds to build out a 4G wireless infrastructure for Public Safety across the U.S.
